Helpful uniform information

- a. The academy's lavender shirt, PE jumper, blazer and jumper can be purchased from the [Price and Buckland website](#). They are our only uniform provider. If you are currently experiencing financial difficulties, email the school or send a note to your child's Head of Year or ESA. Second-hand uniform items are also available from the academy. Email cga@clapton.hackney.sch.uk for more information.
- b. Your child's black, tailored school trousers, their black hijab, their plain white PE polo shirt, their PE black jogging bottoms or leggings and black knee-length skirt can be purchased from high street retailers. Tube skirts, "skinny" trousers, branded PE polo shirts, patterned hijabs, are not allowed. Trousers must not be shorter than ankle length.
- c. Shoes must not be higher than the anklebone. Students are not allowed to wear trainers.

- d. Fake nails are not allowed. Students wearing fake nails will have to work in the Student Support Centre until the nails are removed.
- e. False eyelashes are not allowed. This includes both adhesive lashes and individual extensions. Students wearing false eyelashes will have to work in the Student Support Centre until the false eyelashes are removed.
- f. All students must wear their blazer when on the academy's site. This will be expected at the morning gates and throughout the day.
- g. If your child has outgrown their uniform, please donate their old uniform to the academy to support other families.
