#### Year 13 Exams and Study Leave

Year 13 A-Level exams begin on Tuesday 14 May and end on 21 June. Study leave for Year 13 will begin on Monday 13 May. Students will not need to be present for Collective Time, PSHCE or Supervised Study. Students are encouraged to continue attending their A-Level lessons until exams are finished in that subject. 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#### Year 10 Pre-Public Exams

Year 10 students will be sitting their first round of Pre-Public Exams (PPEs) from 24 June to 5 July. Students have been issued with individual PPE timetables so that they are clear when their exams take place. To support Year 10 students with understanding how to organise their GCSE revision and recommended revision techniques, we are holding compulsory revision masterclasses after school from 2.50-4pm on how students can 'revise to succeed' in their exams.

The schedule of masterclasses is: Wednesday 8 May - 10C and 10N; Wednesday 15 May - 10L and 10T and Wednesday 22 May - 10A and 10P

Students will only need their normal equipment: planner and pencil case. Revision will play a vital role in students' success in their GCSE exams next summer. Please ensure that you give consent for the master-class by clicking on the links in the Evolve email sent to all Year 10 parents.
