A year ago today, our Year 12 student, Maryam Dawud, sadly passed away in her sleep. Today we will be remembering Maryam and celebrating her life. Maryam was a valued and well-respected member of the CGA family and has been deeply missed by all who knew her.

Maryam's friends described her as a student that always quietly did the right thing. Last year, staff and students made origami butterflies with messages to remember Maryam. This week, these have been put into displays around our LRC which students can visit for quiet moments of reflection.



At the time of Maryam's passing, the CGA community contributed generously to fund a memorial for Maryam. At the request of students, we have used these funds to plant a magnolia tree by main reception. This tree is named 'Heaven Scent'. We look forward to seeing the tree grow and blossom and to it becoming a space for reflection and remembrance.
