

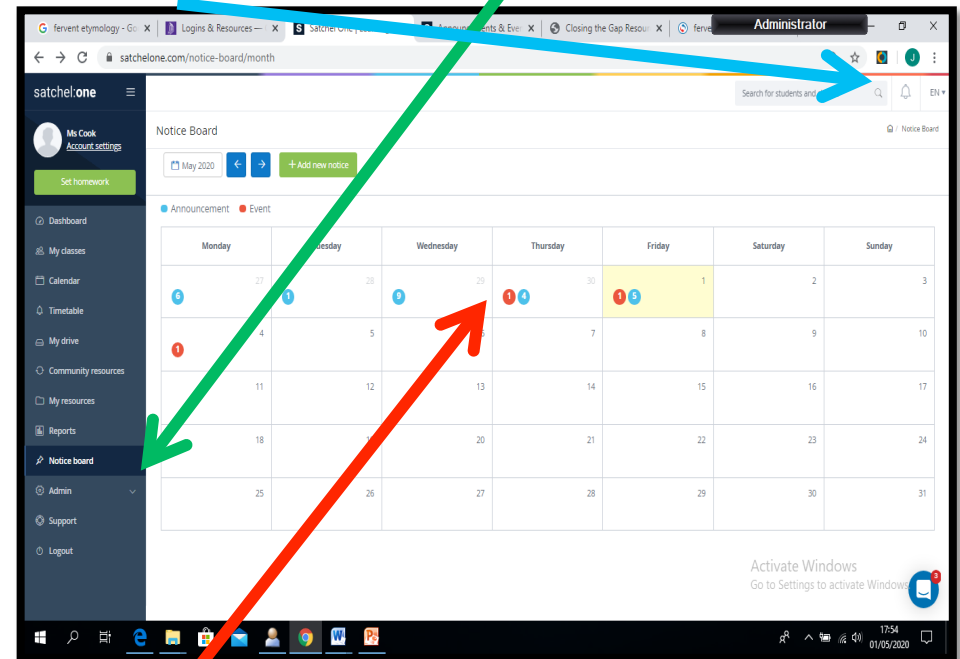


1. To start your school day read **student notices**.

You can find student notices on satchel:one (previously SMHW) in two ways (you choose!)

1. It will be set as a piece of HW. You can find this on:
 - The school calendar
 - Your to-do list
 - Your calendar
2. You can find it on the school noticeboard

Log into your account and click **Notice board** on the left-hand menu. Notifications for any new announcements or events will also be displayed in the **bell icon** at the top-right of the page.



Announcements appear as blue dots on the Notice Board. Events (including student notices) appear as **red dots**. Click on the dot to read more information about the event.



2. Watch the weekly **assembly** once a week.

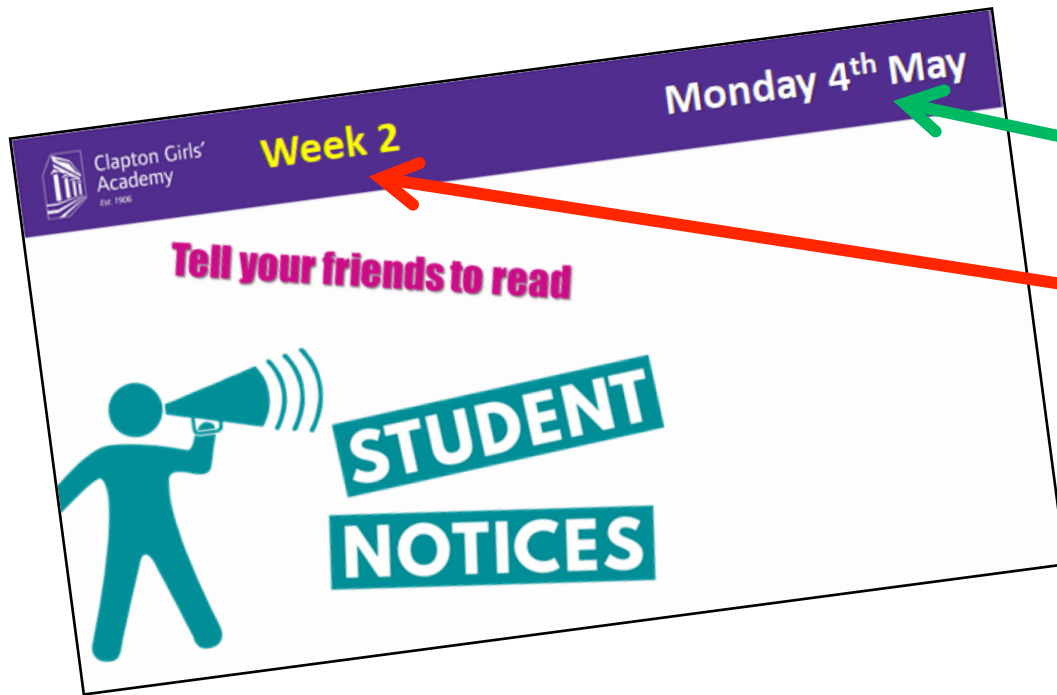
The assembly will be set as a piece of HW. You can find this on:

Task description

Hello Year 8!

As you know, you should be aiming to spend as much time on English at home as you would in a normal week of school. The tasks this week are a combination of creative writing and revising written accuracy, which complement each other well, and should take about three hours to complete.

Top tip: take your time on the creative writing tasks. It's always a good idea to plan, and to include as much detail as you can. Don't be afraid to cross things out and start again; redrafting is part of the creative writing process :)

The **first two hours** are tasks from this term's booklet (attached to this post):

- 1 hour: writing from a picture (page 8 in attached booklet)

If you have time left over you can:

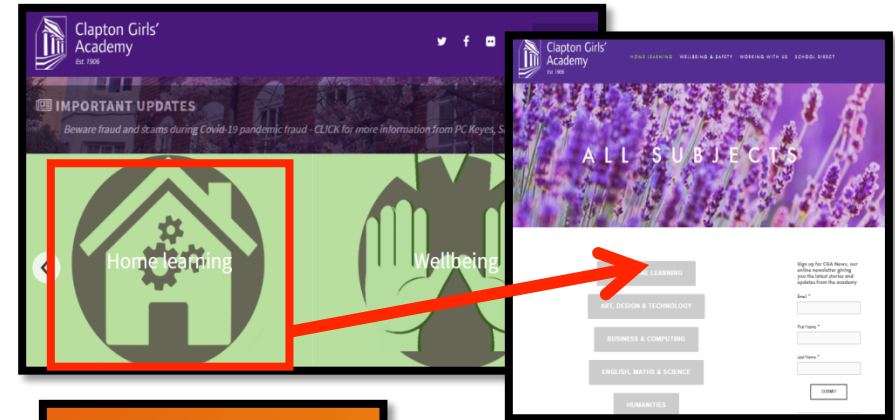
- focus on your independent reading
