# Arrangements for Years 7,8,9,and 12

# I am sorry to inform you that CGA will be closed to students in Years 7,8,9 and 12 on the 15 and 16 March. We are asking you not to send students in these year groups into school on this day.

We have not taken this decision lightly. We remain committed to providing a safe and secure environment for our students, and feel that we would be unable to provide this with the staff we have available. I'm sorry that you will have to make alternative arrangements for your child, and that they will experience disruption to their education.

Given the number of teaching staff likely to be involved in strike action, we are also unable to provide remote learning for students. Students in years 7, 8 and 9 can continue to complete activities on the presentation that will be provided to them on Satchel:One. Most students in year 10 and Year 12 will need to complete revision, homework and independent study.

# Arrangements for Years 10, 11 and 13

School will be open to those Year 10 students who are completing their PSAs in Business and Health and Social Care on both the 15 and 16 March. It is essential that these students attend both days as this is part of their final qualification. Year 10 students should arrive at the Linscott

Road entrance at 9.45am on both days. Students will finish by 1pm and they can attend school in non-uniform.

School will be open for some Year 11 students on Wednesday 15 March to complete coursework in Creative iMedia, Art, Photography and D&T. These students and parents will be informed individually. They should arrive at the Linscott Road gates at 9.45am and will finish at 2pm. Students can attend in non-uniform.

School will be open to all year 11 students for masterclasses on Thursday 16 March. It is compulsory for all students to attend. Students should arrive at the Laura Place gates at 9.45am and will finish by 1pm. Students can attend in non-uniform.

# School will be open to Year 13 students with Pre-Public Exams (PPEs) on both 15 and 16 Match. Any Year 13 students not completing PPEs should stay at home to complete revision.

- have been identified as otherwise vulnerable by educational providers/local authorities
- are on the edge of receiving support from children's social care services, in the process of being referred to children's services or have previously received support from children's social care services
- are adopted children or on a special guardianship order
- are living in temporary accommodation
- are young carers
