Visit to: (Go)Jump Trampoline Park on Monday 8 July 2024

Our Summer Term Focus Day takes place on Monday 8 July. As part of this, we have organised a Year 7 end of year trip to the "(Go) Jump In" trampoline park in Enfield. The purpose of this visit is to promote student wellbeing, celebrate their achievements this year and build positive relationships between students. The day will begin with activities at the academy. Students are expected to attend Collective Time at the usual time of 8.40am.

Departure Time and Entrance:	10.30am from Linscott Road
Return Time and Entrance:	3pm to Almack Rd. Students return to the academy to be dismissed.
Visit Location:	(Go)Jump, Lumina Park, Lumina Way, Enfield EN1 1FS

About 180 students will attend this visit, supervised by about 14 staff members. The Visit Leader is Tamara Chambers, Head of Year 7.

Students will be offered a 1 hour 'exclusive jump session', as well as team building activities.

Students are asked to contribute £9 which will cover their entry into the venue and the compulsory purchase of 'grip socks'. Please make the requested payment by Monday 3 June via ParentPay. Please email finance@clapton.hackney.sch.uk if you have any concerns about paying for this trip or would like to discuss payment options. Parents wishing to make additional contributions toward funding for students whose families are facing financial difficulty can also do so via ParentPay. Any contribution is appreciated. Please be aware that if we do not receive enough contributions, the visit must be cancelled. In addition, should there be concerns about your child's behaviour, the decision for them to come on this trip may be reviewed.

We will be walking and using London Overground to travel to and from the venue. Students will need £3 on their 'Zip Cards' to cover the cost of travel on the Overground.

Students will need to bring a healthy packed lunch and a water bottle and ensure that they wear suitable clothes for trampolining e.g. leggings or tracksuit bottoms. There is a small café at the trampoline park. Students can bring money with them to purchase refreshments there. Packed lunches will be provided for students who normally receive free school meals.

If your child has a medical need, please ensure that they have their asthma pump, epi-pen etc with them on the day of the trip otherwise they will not be allowed to leave site to attend the trip.
